The Award – (*and there could be more than one in any particular year*) - can be made to individuals, businesses, local organisations, local authorities or other statutory bodies and aims to recognize best practice in improving the local environment.

- A new shop front sensitive to the conservation areas in the town
- Improvements in the local street scene – pavements, walls, roads
- The removal or improvement of a significant eyesore

Applicants for the Award can be self-nominated or nominated by others and the award winner or winners will be selected by a panel which includes the Town Mayor, another Dronfield organisation and the Civic Society. The Award itself will be a framed certificate and will be presented at the Civic Society's AGM in May.
